Dads Honor Ride 2016 Boston to Chicago

Dads Honor Ride is a cycling and fundraising campaign. The inaugural ride, DHR15, took place from June 1-21, 2015. The ride started in Santa Monica, CA, loosely followed the iconic Route 66 and concluded in Chicago on Father's Day at US Cellular Field with an on-field ceremony before the Chicago White Sox baseball game.

DHR16 will be from Boston to Chicago, via Washington, DC from May 30 to June 19, 2016 (Father's Day). 21CDF is budgeting for a limit of 10 riders per day and 70 riders in total in one of three categories:

> 10 one week riders, each raising \$5,000 or more 20 three day riders, each raising \$2,500 or more, and 40 one day riders, each raising \$1,000 or more
